

## Co-Option Criteria for Parish Councillor

Please answer the Yes/No questions carefully as they set out the legal questions for being a Parish Councillor:

QUALIFICATIONS:	
Are you a British citizen, a Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of a European country?	
Are you 18 years old or over?	
You only need one of the following four qualifications but please say Yes to all that apply:	
Are you on the electoral register for the parish?	
Have you lived in the parish of Frampton Cotterell, or within three miles of its boundary, for at least a year?	
Have you been the owner or tenant of land in the parish of Frampton Cotterell for at least a year?	
Have you had your only or main place of work in the parish of Frampton Cotterell for at least a year?	
DISQUALIFICATIONS:	
Are you the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or interim order?	
Have you within the last five years been convicted of an offence in the UK, the Channel Islands, or the Isle of Man which resulted in a sentence of imprisonment (whether suspended or not) for a period of three months or more without the option of a fine?	
Are you disqualified by order of a court from being a member of a local authority?
