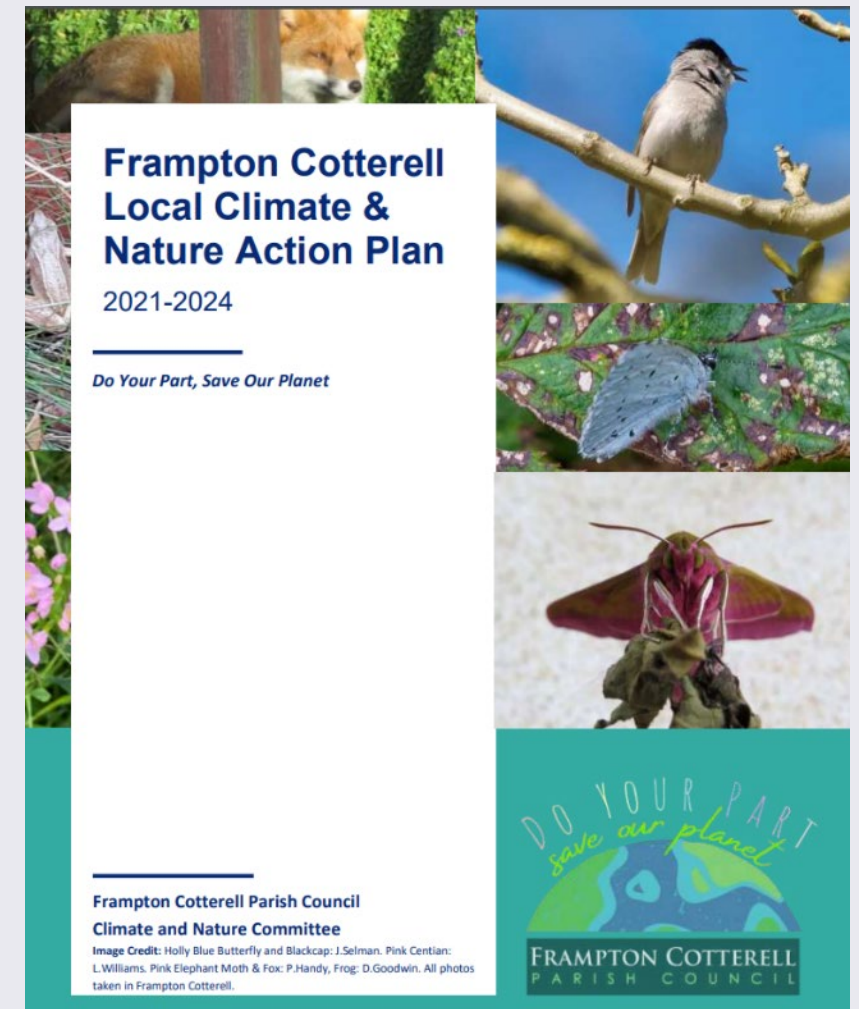
Climate and Nature Emergency Declaration and Environmental Policy approved by FCPC

SOME OF OUR FUTURE PROJECTS

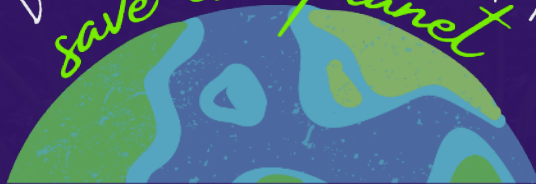
- Species monitoring – dormouse, reptile, pollinators etc
