	The FACE quarter 4 report was considered. Plus a half term trip is planned for the senior youth session. A new youth vehicle is coming to the area funded by VRP (part of SGC) and FACE are hoping to hire this, particularly for the D Day event. IT WAS RESOLVED to note the report	All in favour

	The FACE representatives advised that they are hoping that some of the youngsters will step up to the youth council.	

<b>YS. 9/05/2024-7</b>	<b>SCOUTS REPORT</b>	
	<p>The Scouts representative reported that:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total active young people enrolled in scouting in Frampton Cotterell: 151 plus approx. 75 enrolled at Zeus explorer scouts</li> <li>• 2<sup>nd</sup> Frampton Cotterell has been merged from April 2024 with 1<sup>st</sup> Frampton Cotterell Scout Group, so they will run as one group, still meeting at the two locations: Zion Scout Hut and Crossbow.</li> <li>• they have recently reopened Squirrel Scouts, ages 4-6yrs.</li> <li>• they have 1 squirrel dray, 2 beaver colonies, 2 cub packs, 3 scout troops.</li> <li>• they have a total of 21 leader volunteers, 3 section assistants and 10 parent volunteers for trustee and committee roles.</li> <li>• they currently have a waiting list with a total of 162 young people of various ages who want to join and need more adult volunteers.</li> <li>• A recent fundraising event raised over £1000 which was shared between Bridge House, Bridge House Railway and Scouts. They are fundraising for a new Mess Tent (costing over £1500, and for competition rifles costing £800 each).</li> </ul> <p>IT WAS RESOLVED to note the report.</p> <p>A query was raised on how they decide on the waiting list. The response was that if the child were in the child system they would get a priority place, otherwise it is who ever has waited the longest on the waiting list and a vacancy in the appropriate scouting age group. The advice is to get the child on the waiting list as soon as possible, the youngest age registered was 3 hours old.</p> <p>A councillor suggested that the Scouts apply for a grant from the Council to assist with their fund raising.</p> <p>IT WAS RESOLVED that the Clerk will issue the grant policy and application form to the Scouts for them to submit their application.</p>	<p>All in favour</p> <p>All in favour Clerk</p>
